

Correct Seal Fitting – To Avoid Bolt Seal Tampering



A correctly fitted Ferrollock Seal



This tampering example shows the importance of fitting the **Ferrollock Seal** or for that matter any bolt seal, correctly.

The bolt should be fed through the top latch and the bottom latch eyelets and the locking bush fastened so it hangs down in open view.

Any tampering of the locking head such as spinning (in this case) would be immediately evident and cannot be hidden within the latch eyelet configuration.

This seal fitting method should become a Worldwide Shipping Industry standard for bolt sealing, to ensure an incorrectly fitted seal can be spotted immediately.

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
